Use the w/sheet to make questions for older learners to answer. Younger learners can complete the drawing activity.

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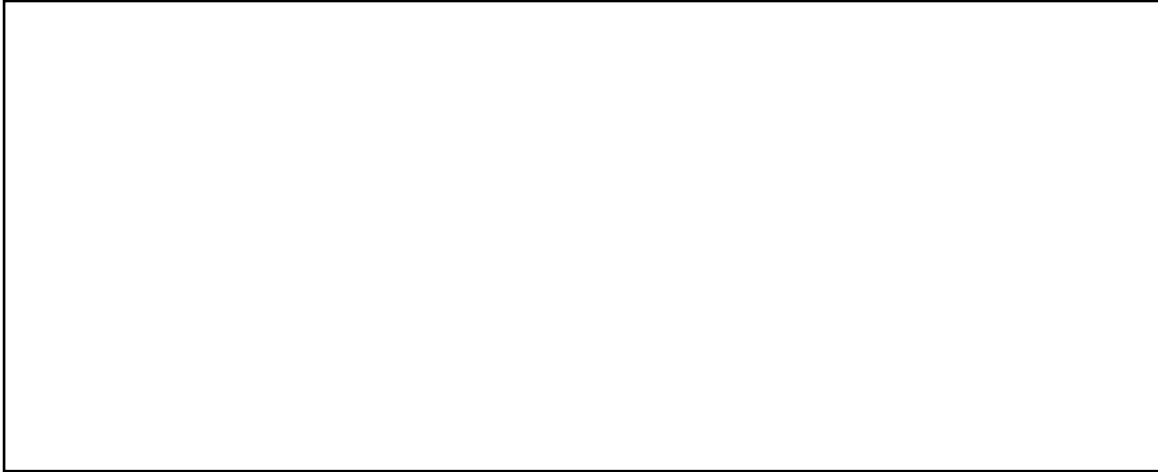

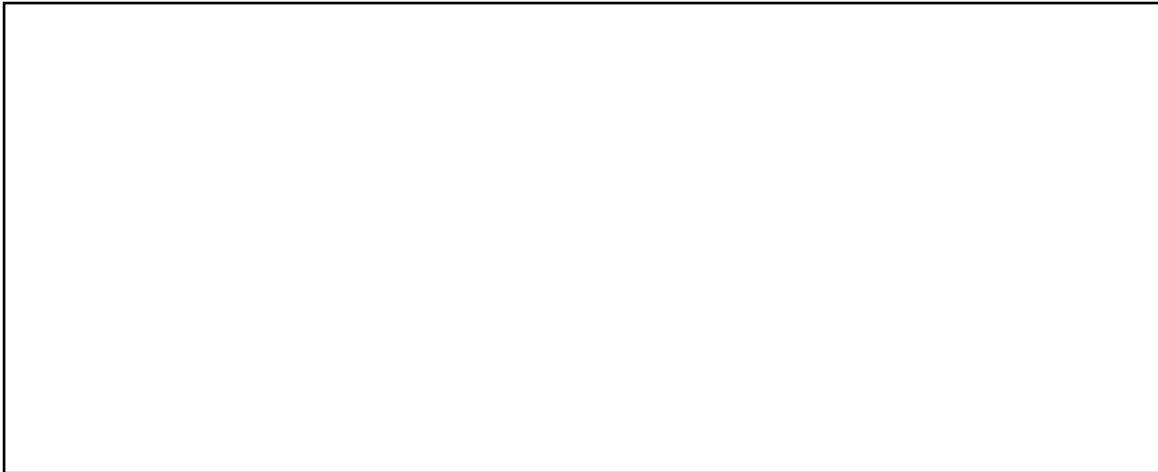

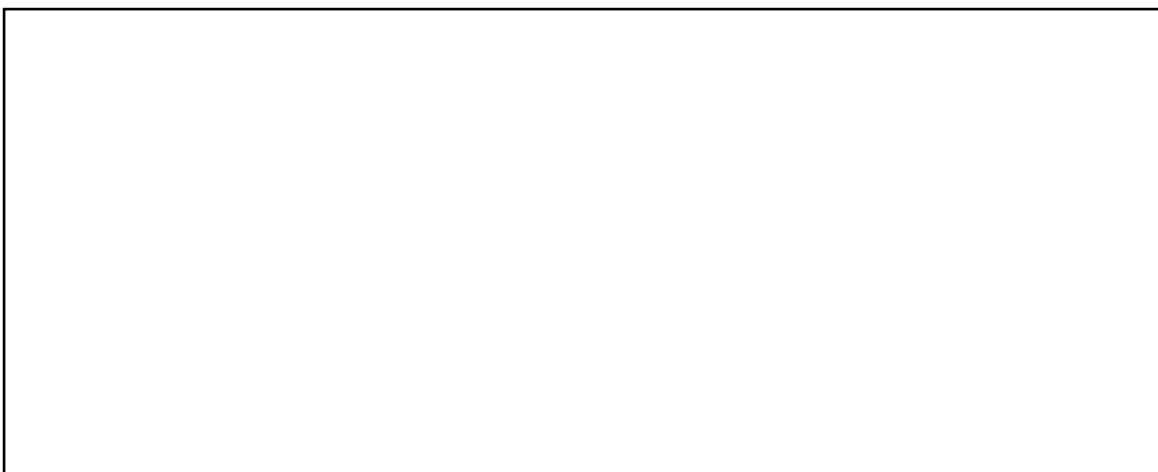
In the past, people did not like to throw things away.



People repaired their old clothes and shoes.




Old clothes were cut up and used as cleaning cloths.
