

Plastic free travel

Pre-task: Talk to learners about the topic of 'going on holiday' and things we pack when we go away. Write down any examples they give of single use plastic, on the board.

Activity ideas

- Ask learners, in groups, to come up with 10 tips for reducing single use plastic when going on holiday/travelling (see examples on 2nd page).
- Ask learners to turn the tips into posters.
- Use the gap fill on page 3 to create a listening activity or discussion about suitable verbs (positive and negative) to fill in the gaps.
- Higher level learners can discuss each tip on the 2nd page and see if they think they are realistic. For example- talking about the length of your flight/holiday, what sorts of amenities you will have when you arrive and how long you will be gone.
